Attendees Guidelines

We sincerely appreciate your commitment to attending the sessions and we are excited to be providing classes and opportunities to connect with your fellow Sangat.

To make sure we get the best out of these sessions, Class attendees should follow guidelines focusing on respect, participation, and punctuality to foster a positive and productive learning environment.

- **Respect Others:** Treat all classmates and the sevadaars with courtesy. This includes listening actively without interrupting, being respectful of diverse perspectives, and using appropriate language.
- **Arrive on Time:** Be present and ready to learn when the class begins. If you are late, enter quietly to minimize disruption.
- **Come Prepared:** Bring all necessary materials (e.g., notebook, pen, completed assignments, relevant readings) and be mentally ready to engage with the topic.
- **Participate Actively:** Contribute to discussions, ask questions for clarification, and engage in all activities. This encourages a collaborative learning environment.
- **Respect the Space:** Help maintain a clean and organized learning environment by cleaning up after yourself and treating classroom property with care.
- **Minimize Disruptions:** Put mobile phones on silent or away unless they are needed for a class activity. Avoid distracting side conversations, eating, or using laptops for non-class activities.
- **Be Accountable:** Take responsibility for your own actions and learning. This includes managing your work and seeking help if you are struggling.
- **Most of all:** Connect with your fellow Sikh Sangat and have fun!

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
